The EACMFS 2024 Gala Dinner will be held at the Palazzo Colonna – Cardinal Colonna Gallery.

The Cardinal Colonna Gallery is the most impressive and majestic historical location in the center of Rome, residence of great charm and rare beauty.

Its construction began in the fourteenth century by the Colonna family and lasted for five centuries leading the overlapping of different architectural styles, interiors and exteriors.

Throughout the 1600s, the Palace took the form of a large Baroque palace and relied on architects and artists of great skill and reputation, such as Gian Lorenzo Bernini, Carlo Fontana, Paolo Schor and many others.

**Private Walk Through Colonna Gallery:** Get the chance to have an exclusive private close-door visit of one of the most magnificent examples of Roman Baroque architecture, located in the very heart of Rome.

Those who decide to buy the ticket for the museum visit will be welcome to reach the Hall dedicated to the Gala Dinner, walking though Galleria Colonna. A unique and immersive experience developped for 76 metres distributed in several halls, serving as the stunning repository for an impressive collection of works of art, with paintings, sculptures and furnishings from the 14th to the 18th century.

The private visit will give the chance to admire masterpieces of absolute excellence created by the greatest Italian and international artists. Among others, **Pinturicchio**, **Cosmè Tura**, **Annibale Carracci**, **Guido Reni**, **Tintoretto**, **Salvator Rosa**, **Bronzino**, **Guercino**, **Veronese and Vanvitelli**.
